The Association of the Flockindustry Europe is from now on called Flock Association of Europe (FAoE) e.V.

Reason for the renaming is the increasing Internationalisation of the Association. 52% of our members are settled in Germany. Additional 34% in Europe and 14% outside of Europe. In the committees and working groups mostly English is spoken.

From 1st of June 2010 the new name of the Association will be Flock Association of Europe (FAoE) e.V. The decision about the name took place in our membership assembly in March 2009.

The Flock Association of Europe was founded in 1981 in Büdingen and sees itself as the central representative of the interests of all companies involved in flock-technology.

Our members and interested parties are supported in questions related to the flock technique. As an Association, it is our first priority to popularize the advantages of flock-technology, and moreover develop flocking to make its application safer and more environmentally friendly. 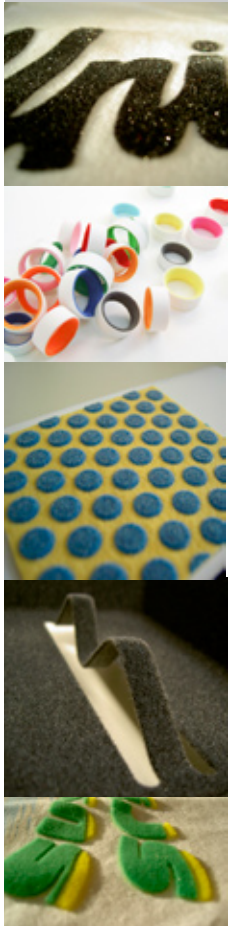
are developed in close cooperation with the customer. For this a well developed laboratory is available.

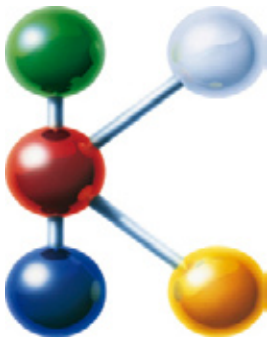



Thesis with Flock – Upgrading techniques of paper

Insider know already: Flocking is a high-class paper upgrading with a very pleasant feel and an exclusive appearance. From time to time there are reports in magazines about the flocking of paper and further techniques to upgrade paper. There has never been a compendium in which the most different kinds of techniques are described and shown. This gap has been filled now with an excellent thesis which we would like to introduce.

In their final term, in summer 2009, Viktoria Steinwandel and Nicole Pfennig, students of Graphic-Design (Freiburg im Breisgau), dealt with the subject upgrading.

The result is a very enlightening book about the subject upgrading of paper. „Kleinod – Mehrwert schaffen durch Veredelung“ (additional benefit with upgrading)

This subject upgrading is very extensive, versatile and huge. Upgrading can be done in very different ways and on different materials. The techniques for it grew gradually and many methods were developed.

Therefore the focus of this book is on upgrading of the print substrate paper

When did upgrading start and why? How did the techniques develop? What are the functions? Is there anything to take care of by processing? Who can do the upgrading of my product? What should I take into account? What is possible? What is the role of the substrate? And how do I set my document?

This book has the answers.

The book includes detailed knowledge about upgrading. Every single technique is described, how it was developed and what needs to be taken into account by designing. The book not only shows what can be done within upgrading but also what lies behind it.



The upgrading is shown on some extra produced samples for this book. The samples are in a consistent concept and play with the natural shyness of touching insects.

On the basis of the samples the benefit of upgrading should be made clear. It is not about attracting attention through exaggeration or straining after effects but more to show the well directed and careful use of the possibilities of upgrading



Flocking is shown with all necessary work steps, the different kinds of materials are listed and important information about the selection of the paper and the time of production are included. Besides several pictures of flocked motives a real flocking can be found on the first pages which was done by our member FLOCK-TEC Technische Beflockungen GmbH in Gomaringen. So you can also feel flock.

It is a book which can be used as utility object. There is also space to enlarge and amend the book yourself so the owner can write down notes, add samples, contactst etc.

Jewellery designer Zoe Robertson launches her new collection of neckpieces Flocking Marvellous. Which have recently been exhibited by Charon Kransen Arts at SOFA Art Fair 2010 (USA) during April and will be exhibited at the Electrum and Lesley Craze galleries in London from May.

These pieces continue to explore her passion for unusual materials where she enjoys the exploration of non-precious unconventional materials. The sensory and aesthetic qualities of materials such as flock fibre, rubber and plastic are of particular interest. This is coupled with new directions into the integration of bold colour and pattern through the investigation of the process, dye sublimation.

Zoe is a full time lecturer at the world renowned School of Jewellery, Birmingham City University, UK. Prior to this she worked within the educational department at the Design Museum in London. Alongside lecturing she is an active designer maker who exhibits her work internationally.



Her most recent accolades include being awarded a Silver Award for Gallery Jewellery for the Goldsmiths Craft and Design Awards 2010 (UK). She was also selected for the European Prize for Applied Arts organised by the World Crafts Council – (Belgium) and the ITAMI International Craft Exhibition (Japan)
